#### Svalbarði

Source: Iceberg Water, Norway

Tasting notes: Clear as crystal, light as feather

Pairings: Salads, sashimi & seafoods

One of the most exclusive & expensive waters in the world, Svalbarði is specially sourced by a specially chartered icebreaker 1,000km from the North Pole at 79° north in Kongsfjorden in the Norwegian island territory of Svalbard – one of Europe's last great wildernesses.

The ice is then gently melted in a specially constructed machine and bottled by hand, capturing the water as fresh as the day it fell as snow up to 4,000 years ago.

The bottle is made from the highest quality extra flint glass and the wooden cap in the colour of arctic driftwood is sourced from sustainable forests.

All bottles have a seal which incorporates Bubble Tag 3d chaosmetric technology to ensure authenticity.

"Svalbarði began with a dream to explore the Arctic. When I visited Svalbard for the first time I discovered the ice was exceptionally clean, with a delightful taste. I know few will ever be able to visit, but with Svalbarði people can taste the best drinking water from the ice at the top of the world."

#### RAW Lava/Ice

Source: Natural Mineral Water, Denmark

Tasting notes: Neutral, crisp with a slight bitter but refreshing bite.

Pairing: Perfect for sashimi & salads. Ideal for palate cleansing.

Sourced from an artesian spring located in Lyngmarks kilden on Disko island north of the Arctic Circle, the spring is fed from melting glaciers of the Greenland mountains through lava stones. Due to the unique geology of the area, the waters are one of the highest pH levels found naturally – 9.38. The very low minerality makes it ideal for detoxification.

# Llanllyr

Source: Natural Mineral Water, Wales, United Kingdom

Tasting notes: A smooth & balanced taste.

Pairing: Great for easy drinking. Ideal for wine pairings.

The source of Hildon is the jewel that lies below the 160-acre estate deep within the Test Valley countryside near the village of Broughton. 50 years of natural filtration through the chalk hills has imbued Hildon with such a specific taste that it is the only bottled water brand to be granted the Royal Warrant of Appointment to The Queen for supplying to the Royal Household.

## Aqua-live

Source: Natural Mineral Water, Australia

Tasting notes: Smooth and creamy, with a slight hint of sweetness.

Pairing: Saucy meats & desserts

Aqui-Live is an ancient water which rises naturally to surface, taking more than 2,000 years to complete its journey. The source is the Palaeolithic Basement, a 700m deep aquifer on the Mornington Peninsula, Victoria, in Australia that is claimed by hydrogeologists to be 600 million years old. Along the way, the water is infused with up to 22 essential minerals from the mineral rich geology, giving the water its delicious taste profile.

### Güitig

Source: Natural Mineral Water, Ecuador

Tasting notes: Complex. Almost savoury with a nice mouthfeel.

Pairing: Fine dining water. Excellent with cheeses, lamb & beef.

The source of water originates from snowmelt in the Ecuadorian Andes, where it is naturally filtered through the mountains, acquiring minerals with extraordinary properties. It finally emerges at The Tesalia Springs fountains in Machachi, Ecuador as a very special, delicious naturally carbonated water. It was 1902 when Güitig was first bottled and transported on a mule's back to towns. Today, Güitig is bottled luxuriously in a designer glass for your finest enjoyment.

#### ORO

Tasting notes: A very sophisticated water with sweet & bitter notes.

Pairing: Saucy meats & desserts

The region where ORO hails from has important historical significance and is known as Via Egnatia. It has been visited by many Emperors, Tsars, Kings & Queens and Aristocrats, including Apostle Paul during his missionary journey, throughout time in European history. Known for its naturally effervescent qualities and rich magnesium content, the waters have been long sought after for bathing and drinking to exploit its healing properties.
